AS WE GATHER

Here's the question for today: What are you afraid of, really? Each of us might give quite different responses to the question. Maybe you're afraid of snakes or spiders. You might be afraid of failure or judgment. The presence of Jesus through the Holy Spirit turns everything upside down and inside out. We live in the daily tension of feeling hopeless and left for dead and trusting that Jesus is our Good Samaritan who binds our wounds, picks us up, and provides for our care. In our worship today we'll explore how we might all be wounded travellers lying at the side of the road, needing to get beyond our fears and ask someone else for help.
