AS WE GATHER

Death is a part of life. In our text for today there's quite a discussion between Jesus and the Sadducees. The Sadducees didn't believe in a resurrection. For them, death was it; over! But Jesus affirms there will be a resurrection. It is God's Dream to recreate his creation. In eternal life, there will be no more death in all its form.

In a world so focused on the here and now...living in the present and fearing the future...cherishing our youth and fighting against the signs of aging...it's easy to lose sight of the simple truth - we are "children of the resurrection!" Lean on the Lord who loves you and will never let you go. Let go of the fear that works to cloud our vision of eternal life. Pray for the strength to let go of the daily and focus on the eternal. Remember that you have a place in God's dream.
