AS WE GATHER

Today we start a new worship series called "Alignment." If you want to know what someone believes, just watch what they do or how they feel. Sometimes our beliefs and our actions don't align with the God who created us. This series will explore the possibility of aligning our behaviour with our beliefs. Today we begin at the beginning, Genesis chapter one, and consider what it means to be aligned with the God of creation.

Being aligned with the God of Creation is an amazing invitation: to truly live out our beliefs by taking care of this world; to answer the call to community...with God, with each other, and with God's creation; to recognize just how awesome it is to be held in the palm of that hand.

PRAYER OF THE DAY

Eternal God, you have revealed yourself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and you live in the perfect unity of love. You are in the beginning and in eternity. You created and are still creating. You are renewing, restoring, and reconciling all of creation. In our worship, align our hopes and dreams to what you intend for your creation in Jesus' name. Amen!
